Supervisor Hoffman called the meeting to order at 6:02. Members present at roll call were Supervisor Hoffman, Clerk Collins, Treasurer Smith, Trustee Schaller, absent Trustee Cervone. One member of the public was present at the meeting.

The Clerk presented 7 possible salary resolutions. The first resolution #8 was for an increase in the hourly employees of a \$1.00 an hour increase. After a brief discussion. A **Motion** by Smith to approve a \$1.00 an hour increase for the hourly employees. **Supported** by Schaller. Roll call vote Hoffman, yes, Collins, yes, Cervone, yes, Schaller, yes, Smith, yes. All in favor. Motion Carried.

SALARY RESOLUTION # 8 OF 2020

WHEREAS, pursuant to MCLA 41.95(3), which provides that in a township that does not hold an annual meeting, the salary for officers composing the township board shall be determined by the township board, and

WHEREAS, the board of COLDSPRINGS TOWNSHIP deems it desirable to adjust the wages of hourly employees to ensure that compensation for this position remains equitable and commensurate with hourly wages, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that as of April 1, 2020 the wages of all Hourly Employees shall be as follows: \$14.00 per hour with the exception of the Maintenance person and Election Chairperson which will receive \$16.00 per hour

SALARY RESOLUTION #9 of 2020

WHEREAS, the board of COLDSPRINGS TOWNSHIP deems it desirable to adjust the salary of the Township Assessor to ensure that compensation for this position remains equitable and commensurate with the duties of said elective office, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that as of April 1, 2020 the salary of the Township Assessor shall be as follows: \$30,900.00 per year.

Clerk Collins also gave a copy of the updated Assessor's contract to Supervisor Hoffman to have the Assessor sign the new contract. The Contract will be approved at the March Regular Board Meeting.

The Clerk presented the other 5 possible salary resolutions. And after a brief discussion a **Motion** by Schaller to no salary increase for township Board Members. **Supported** by Cervone. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

The clerk presented a copy of the proposed 2020-2021 budget with a taxable value of \$114,550,600. Each line item in the proposed budget was reviewed by the board. A Resolution to adopt General Fund Budget by Cost Center will be voted on at the Regular Township Board Meeting.

No public comments were made.

Motion by Smith to adjourn at 6:49 **Supported** by Cervone. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
